I'm writing to object to the planning application 2021/1813/P - for the installation of an over sized 5G mast by the entrance to Primrose Hill Park.

This is a conservation area and the park is a huge draw for people looking for a respite from city life and to spend time in nature. We need to protect our green spaces and this mast would be an eyesore and completely out of keeping with the park and the local area.

The mast is enormous and completely out of proportion with the surrounding street lamps and trees. To have it in such a prominent place would ruin the view of the park from the nearby houses and for visitors coming to use the park. The edge of the park is a clean stretch of path with just the railings and lampposts down towards the village - the installation would completely ruin the visual effect of the parks perimeter and it would be unfortunate to set a precedent that anything can be stuck up anywhere in the area no matter how unsuitable.

There are alternative more industrial sites in the area where the mast would be less obvious. However in it's proposed (unsuitable) location it would stick out like a sore thumb and completely ruin the feel of the park and surrounding area.

Please reject this planning application and rethink the masts location.
