As a practice, we would like to register an objection to this proposal.

Whils we understand that this is not an easy object to locate to choose to locate it against the Hill which provides some of the most peaceful and relaxing views would seem completely inappropriate and unacceptable.

We have spent many years of our lives trying to improve the environment in Primrose Hill.

This mast is a brutish object that cannot be concealed by trees - as shown in the attached images

It would sit adjacent sub area 1 of the Conservation Area. If the usual rules of judgment were applied, we cannot see how it could possibly be deemed 'to preserve and enhance' the Conservation Area

There must be a better location than this.

If not, Primrose Hill has survived this long with the level of mobile communication to be expected in a rural area, and maybe it will have to continue to do so.

This at least should be a matter for public debate.
