As a former resident of Primrose Hill, I lived at 108 Regent's Park Road for 31 years.  
I still return there to see friends and to enjoy the air and beauty of the park and surrounding area.

The proposed plan to erect an eyesore of a mast, as well as cabinets, along the pavement at the corner of the park, will ruin the timeless beauty of the road.

It will mar the views of the Park for the houses in Regent's Park Road and those in Albert Terrace.

The mast and cabinets will constrict the pavement near the entrance to the children's playground, and dwarf the historic drinking fountain.

Regent's Park Road is a scenic tree-lined avenue, especially beautiful where it opens out with the Park on one side and the Victorian stucco houses on the other.

I write to record my objection to this unfortunate idea to sabotage one of London's most famous landmarks, and one of its loveliest places to live.
