FRONT GARDEN: Large Copper Beech in front garden of 22 Upper Park Road, NW3 2UP (Easting 527670, northing 185020)

The tree has grown very large. We wish to trim/reduce the height of the crown, and possibly thin the crown as well. There is no sign of ill health but to be cautious and minimise any future subsidence or risk we feel it needs trimming. In 2019 we contacted Camden about the boundary pillar & low front wall next to the tree, which had become unsafe. We had the wall rebuilt around the tree and rebuilt the pillar. However, the new wall only allows a few inches of growth, and we hope that trimming the tree will limit the expansion of its girth. Our wish is to maintain the character of the tree. We would appreciate a visit by a Camden tree officer to discuss this.
