I am writing on behalf of the BCAAC regarding planning application 2021/0345/P.

We would like to object to this application.

The Design and Access Statement is very limited and makes no mention of the fact that the building is located in a conservation area, or that it is a positive contributor.

As such there is minimal analysis of the impact the proposed changes will have upon the heritage of the building and the area.

We are also concerned that the proposed new ducting will block existing windows, as demonstrated by the existing and proposed north rear elevation document.
