The Council has considered your application for prior approval of siting and appearance in respect of the telecommunications equipment described above determines that prior approval is required and hereby **refuses approval** for the following reason.

## Reason for Objection

The proposed telecoms equipment, by reason of its height, bulk, size and location, would result in overly dominant visual clutter in a prominent position which would cause material harm to the character and appearance of the street scene, local views, Primrose Hill MOL, the Grade II listed park, and Primrose Hill Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design), D2 (Heritage) and A2 (Open space) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2019.
