I realise that you are receiving this objection after the deadline, but I hope that you will nonetheless take it into account. I was only alerted to this application at the end of last week, which I am sure you will agree is most inconsiderate.

I would like to object in the strongest possible terms as the proposed works will impact extremely adversely on the Western Terrace of Fitzroy Square.

Firstly the proposed development is extremely close to the rear windows of the Western Terrace and would therefore effect the quality of life of the people living and working there. There would obviously be a reduction in daylight and sunlight and the inevitability of being overlooked. Also I query the fact that it will then become higher than other buildings in the immediate vicinity, without providing much more accommodation for families.

Having pointed out my objections I would like to end by saying that I feel this will have a detrimental effect on the Fitzroy Conservation Area.
