Nonetheless, personalisation of the space outside is evident at the Ground floor level but there is no alteration to the structure. I have been told this is all that residents of Gayton Place are permitted to undertake under their freehold/leasehold covenants.
				As the partial drawing "Existing rear elevation" shows, the appearance of the next door house is exactly the same as its neighbour. Indeed, it is exactly the same as all the other four houses in the terrace. If you wish to confirm this, please let me know.
