PRIMARY SCHOOL) BUILDING'S EXTERNAL YARD.

This Submission has been noted with great concern by many adjoining residents who are located immediately next and round the three flanks of the small open air application site which is intended for the placement and operation of extensive airconditioning plant...

There is the common concern that the mechanical plant units will emit operational noise 24/7 and that this noise will be detrimental to the residents who have windows, balconies and terraces right next to the proposed machinery 2, 3 and 4 floors above the anticipated noise source.

Besides the anticipated airbourne noise rising from the concrete pit either direct or via echo developments, there could be additionally noticable vibration from the wall mounting of the machinery to the open concrete structure pit walls, etc.

As a respectable Planning Authority you will be entitled to safeguard the justifyably concerned residents from these anticipated negative intrusions to their lives with appropriate conditions and quality assurancy guarantees enforce-able over the duration of the machinery and its eventual replacement.
