Also, I recently went out one morning to find a large cherry tree at the end of Rossendale Way had collapsed and completely blocked the road.

The Silver Birch at the rear of 19 Bergholt Mews is also very worrying as it is growing in a raised bed with insufficient room for its roots. Again, in periods of high wind it causes real alarm to those living in its vicinity.. It really is only a matter of time before it comes down and causes untold damage to life, limb and property.
