Dear Kate,

Very glad to talk just now.

I have excellent video footage of traffic at 10am today, including an accident between a bus and two cars right outside the warehouse site, next to Lyndale Avenue bus stop and busy pavement. These videos capture the complex multi-directional traffic, congestion and dangerous driving, which must be seen to be believed. I witness near-accidents on a daily basis including traffic cutting in front of TFL buses and near-collisions with pedestrians. Too many people and vehicles pour into this micro-area at the junction of the A41/Finchley Rd, at the edge of a major residential/conservation area, it can't cope with more.

Much representation was made to Camden regarding this micro-area adjacent to Briardale Gardens (traffic chief Louise McBride was involved); Camden investigated, introduced limited traffic controls at Briardale Gardens in 2018 and there will be records. Many school children use this pavement taking TFL buses. School buses to Haberdashers, North London Collegiate also collect and deliver at this stretch.

I look forward to getting your DropBox details.

When you receive the videos I would so appreciate if you could indicate that you have received them (I am not confident with modern technology and will worry you haven't).
