I fully support all the tree works proposed in planning application 2021/2926/T recently submitted to Camden by Roger Sharpe, Arborist, Places for People.

Since August 2020 two large trees in Elm Village have collapsed:

- The first was a large Elm with a spread of over 20 metres which fell without warning onto a grassy play area used by children and adults on the afternoon of Friday 21 August last year. It was only luck and good fortune that no-one was injured, and property damage was limited to two cars and a few broken fences.
- The second was a large wild cherry in poor condition that had grown at an angle. On the morning of Tuesday 4 May '21 it collapsed across Rossendale Way, completely blocking it until the tree surgeon arrived and removed it several hours later.

I believe these tree works will make our streets safer and more beautiful for all residents in the years and decades to come.
