

Design & access statement to accompany listed building consent application.

Replacement Balcony pillars

2 Park Village East, London, NW1 7PX

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1.0 Introduction

This statement details the proposal to repair and replace decorative balcony pillars on first floor of the western elevation of property. Minimum of 2 out of 8 pillars need replacing with the possibility that all 8 will be replaced dependent on full survey.

2.0 Hadingham Kirk Gardens

There is no design work undertaken as replacement and repair is to be like for like.

5.0 Access

Access to the building will not be affected.

6.0 Summary

The works are in keeping with what would generally be expected in terms of upkeep and maintenance of a house of this age and design.

There will be minimal impact on the surrounding area during the works and no visible change to the design or appearance of the building once works are completed.

The proposal will not affect the setting of the Conservation Area.
