I am writing as a resident of Finchley Road, with regards to the proposed 'change of use application' to open a Jiffy in the Basement of Cascades Apartments, Finchley Road, London, NW3 7AJ (reference number 2021/2446/P).

I have a flat opposite this location (Flat 29 Moreland Court) and am very concerned about the disruption that a Jiffy in this location will cause. Finchley road is already a very congested, with significant traffic at the junction with Hendon way and with an Amazon-style warehouse at this point there will be significant increase in noise and air pollution, as well as traffic on this main road and neighbouring roads (Lyndale Avenue, Church walk, Briardale Gardens etc). This is a residential location, with a primary school just a minute away (at the end of Church Walk) and lots of children taking public transport to and from school. It is not in-keeping with the nature of the local community to have a Jiffy in this location open late into the night, and it will be very dangerous and harmful to the residents across the Camden and Barnet boroughs that live on either side of the road.

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I would like to share my objection to this application as it will cause significant damage to residential amenity and highway safety – and on a personal level, it will cause increased noise and pollution where I live, potential dangerous driving right beside a bus stop that is in constant use, and greater anti-social activity when there is a business operating until 11pm in a residential setting.
