This application involves an extension across the back of the house. I have the following comments to make.

1. This extension is over development of a house. These houses are large family homes and really do not need such extensions that spoil their neighbours outlook.
2. Its flank walls will take substantial light from the adjoining houses, darkening the basement rooms and patios.
3. This construction will encourage neighbouring houses to follow suit if they have to avoid the light problem.

Please will you fully consider these points and reject the proposal. One possibility is for these flank walls to have a sloping roof to allow better light to adjoin properties.
