Dear Panel Members, RE: APP\PREMISES-NEW\105681 for Pratt Food & Wine, 31a Pratt Street NW1 0BG The situation for residents around Camden Town is already intolerable. This application for a new off sales premises in the centre of town is completely unacceptable. They have made no suggestions as to how they would uphold the councils licensing objectives to prevent public nuisance. We object on the grounds of public nuisance. They are seeking off sales from 08:00hrs until 23:00hrs Mon-Sat and from 12:00hrs until 22:

30hrs on Sunday. That's 15hrs of alcohol sales most days. There is already a significant problem in Camden with street drinking and the resulting anti-social behaviour that impacts residents and indeed visitors and tourists in the area. The result of this street drinking is damage to property, violent behaviour, increased littering, broken glass, street urination, vomiting, and defecation. There is no shortage of premises to purchase alcohol with many licenced supermarkets and off-licenses already established in the surrounding area. If approved this licence will add to the cumulative impact within the cumulative impact zone and have a negative impact on residents. There are no mitigating measures that we can offer as conditions that would reduce the impact of this application if approved. We urge you to refuse this application in its entirety.
