Proposal: Details of sustainable urban drainage system required by condition 8 of permission reference 2020/0728/P dated 03/02/2021 (Demolition of existing buildings (Class B2); erection of 5 storey building (plus rooftop pavilions/plant and basement) to provide a mixed Class C2/D1 healthcare facility (Sui Generis).
