As my room faces onto the garden, I am very worried about the implications of felling the tree for my privacy at home, as without the tree my bedroom would be in full view of 27 Buckland Crescent and other properties on that road. I am also concerned about the impact of felling the tree on my garden, which would become a much less green, private and pleasant space, and on the area as a whole, which would see its air quality significantly reduced, as the property is located very close to Swiss Cottage which has some of the worst air pollution in London. As well as affecting everyone in the area, especially those suffering from asthma and other breathing difficulties, it would also affect me personally as my severe hayfever is significantly worsened by high levels of air pollution.
