Epicormic growth - Remove from base. to allow detailed inspection of base. Clear up to 3m.

T282 - Malus sp. (Apple sp.):
Fell - Ground level. due to poor structural condition and limited future retention value.
Plant replacement tree. (Acer campestre 'Elsrijk') of heavy standard size, in a suitable location nearby.
