2021/3102/P	The Heath & Hampstead Society	09/08/2021 11:20:09	OBJ	<p>OBJECTION</p> <p>From: THE HEATH & HAMPSTEAD SOCIETY</p> <p>The rear elevation of this line of terrace houses can be seen from the Heath.</p> <p>Each extension at roof level has set-back balconies or angled slate or other roofing materials and has retained the white rendered original elevations.</p> <p>The application`s garden elevations do not show the adjacent buildings - a serious omission.</p> <p>The proposed stair well at roof level, contrary to all the neighbours, extends the rendered rear wall face above all the adjoining terraces.</p> <p>As can be seen from the vertical section (included in the application) the wall does not need to extend up to top roof level but could easily be angled back in the manner of adjacent buildings and not rendered - (using roof-slates perhaps)</p> <p>The continuous vertical window to the stair well also conflicts with the other typical sash windows of this row of terrace houses.</p> <p>Please refuse - unless the top of the stair well is set back and the vertical stair well window is revised to conform to the existing format.</p>
