Please see below the response and relevant attachments to the comments made by Thames Water.

## 1. Piling Layout

It is our understanding that Thames Water requires 3m clearance for CFA piles from TW assets. We attach a document called *Bedford Passage Development TW Asset plan & piling layout.* 

The doc includes the TW asset plan, AECOM's current piling layout for the site MHA-ACM-00-B1-DR-SE-01012-C2, and a part overlay of the TW asset plan onto the piling plan.

The overlay focuses on the only TW asset in proximity to the site that is to be piled, which is a combined drain at the south east corner of the site which runs to the street sewer in Charlotte Street. This sewer was confirmed to be abandoned by Thames Water, and removal of the sewer was approved on 09.06.2020. The email correspondence from TW is attached. The above was notified in AECOM's letter to London Borough of Camden c/o Llewelyn Davies dated 16<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

In addition, the TW asset plan has been marked-up to show the footprint of the overall (Bedford Passage Development) site and the proportion of the site to be piled. It is confirmed that the site is inbound of surrounding roads; namely Cleveland Street to the west, and Charlotte Street to the east. All adjoining owners to the site have been notified of the proposed development through formal agreements under the Party Wall etc. Act 1996.

### 2. Basement footprint

AECOM confirms that the proposed basement is confined within the footprint of the proposed secant piled wall shown on the attached piling drawing MHA-ACM-00-B1-DR-SE-01012-C2 i.e. between grids A-H/1-10+.

## 3. Advice on abandonment of assets.

As advised in (1) above, the Thames Water combined sewer adjoining UCL Astor College was confirmed to be abandoned by Thames Water, and removal of the sewer was approved on 09.06.2020. The email correspondence from TW is attached, and the above was notified in AECOM's letter to London Borough of Camden c/o Llewelyn Davies dated 16th June 2020.

I trust that this satisfies Thames Water's queries but please let me know if you need any further information.
