We strongly object to the application for 5 metre tall antennae within the setting of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area.

Rooftop plant, especially when visible, is to be resisted as impacting negatively upon views and the character of the host building and surrounding buildings.

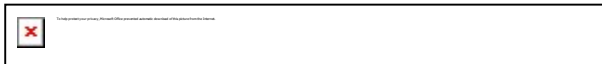
The scale of these antennae at 5 metres tall and perched at the edge of the building's rooftop is completely unacceptable.

The precedent that would be set for visually obtrusive rooftop plant if approved should also be taken into account.

There is very little public benefit associated with this application that would outweigh this harm.

We therefore strongly object.
