As shown on the proposed drawings, a vent pipe would be installed on the rear elevation of the dwellinghouse contrary to B. 1 (e) and C1. 1 (d) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended). However, Householders Technical Guidance states under Class B.1 (e) (ii) that:

"Whilst these [soil vent pipes] are not permitted development under Class B of Schedule 2 to the Order, they may be permitted development under Class G."

Therefore, it is considered as the vent pipe proposed would comply with Class G, it would be permitted development.

As such, the proposed development is permitted under Class B, Class C and Class G Part 1 Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) and is therefore considered to be permitted development.
