List 646

2021/3133/T. St Anne's Church

No objection to the work on the Ash, Fruit trees or sycamores.

They do need reduction.

2021/3855/T. The Towers, 39 Dartmouth Park Avenue

The smooth bark, with lenticles, indicate a Sorbus, mountain ash, rowan, as opposed to Fraxinus the common ash. The three trees on the right should be felled as they will compete with each other and not grow to maturity. Personally, I prefer the tree on the left to the concrete post, but realise that the owners, The Clarion Group, have to maintain their boundaries. You may or may not consider a TPO on the left hand tree.

2021/3893/T. No 19 Grove Terrace

No objection to the reduction in height of the Indian Bean tree or overhang of neighbours's gardens.

2021/3950/T. 18 Laurier Road

No objection to the proposed canopy reduction, balance and shaping of the Magnolia tree.
