It will also inevitably lead, while it is in place, to a degradation of the appearance of this important example of landscape management. The cost of admission indicates that it is beyond the reach of families and people with only modest means. I am not sure whether this is a planning issue but I am concerned whether this long period of closing of part of the grounds is in accord with the terms of the Iveagh bequest which, as I understand it, left Kenwood and its grounds to be enjoyed free of charge by the public. I raised a number of questions about the event some weeks ago with English Heritage at Kenwood but have so far received no answer.
