2021/2861/P	Jonathan Sale	03/09/2021 10:42:29	OBJ	<p>As the Chair of the Glenhurst Avenue Residents' Association, I would like to draw to your attention that there has been some difficulty in registering objections on the website and therefore the number of opponents to the scheme may be greater than it appears.</p> <p>I endorse the submission of Kay Lavington (7 Ravenswood, part of Glenhurst Avenue):</p> <p>"I object to the installation of plant units at Spectrum House on Elevation 5 for two reasons. 1. They are unsightly and over time plant units of this type become more noisy. We overlook the wall that they have been installed on.</p> <p>2. Camden Council should not sanction the oversailing of Council (or publicly) owned land. By allowing this aspect of the application Camden Council will over time give a private landowner rights of access over public land. This is not in the public interest and may stymie later plans from Camden council."</p> <p>I also wish to complain about the lighting from Spectrum House courtyard which is often on all night. It is very high lux and is inappropriate as the housing on the boundary is residential and the bedrooms look onto Spectrum House. The light is keeping me and my daughter awake. It is white light and very bright in our bedrooms. A warmer coloured light, which is low-level and low lux and only on when needed, should be installed. At the moment it is like backing onto a supermarket car park. Both the external facing plant and the lighting degrade the character and amenity of the conservation area."</p>
