While the form and shape of the proposals are acceptable this shiny material, apparently to be animated at night by coloured lights, is completely inappropriate and harmful to the conservation area generally and in particular for this modest but well made modernist building whose palette of materials, buff brick and powder coated metal is much more suitable. The proposed new canopies should be flat powder coated pressed metal in keeping with the host building. While writing we also regret that there is nothing in the proposals to improve the facade at ground level onto Bernard St. which is a chaos of signage and blind shop fronts detracting from the setting of the fine tube station opposite.</p> <p>Hugh Cullum Christiane Ten-Hoopen</p>
