It is an important terrace of town houses with significant architectural merit. They are substantial family homes with garages that keep the already congested streets clear of additional car parking. They also support the ongoing, albeit slow transition to electric vehicles as they can house charging points within the premises footprint.		
				The proposal for changes to the garage doors on the front street level will destroy the frontage of this terrace and is completely out of character with the terrace. In addition, the light gained by this change to the garage door would not provide sufficient daylight to such a deep space. Its also hard to see how they would get sufficient thermal insulation with this proposal.		
				The complete re-configuration of the rear fa¿ade is also unacceptable. Other applications have been rightly rejected in the past. If this application is approved, it will open the gates to a mishmash of roof frontages that will negatively impact the conservation area. This terrace is a very important piece of 1970¿s architecture and integral to this Conservation Area a integrity of its external fa¿ade (front and back) should be preserved.
