1 No advertisement is to be displayed without the permission of the owner of the site or any other person with an interest in the site entitled to grant permission.

2 No advertisement shall be sited or displayed so as to

(a) endanger persons using any highway, railway, waterway, dock, harbour or aerodrome (civil or military);

(b) obscure, or hinder the ready interpretation of any traffic sign, railway signal or aid to navigation by water or air; or

(c) hinder the operation of any device used for the purpose of security or

surveillance or for measuring the speed of any vehicle

1 Reasons for granting consent-

The replacement fascia and projecting signs use existing brackets and lighting arrangements and will match the size and location of the existing signs. They are considered acceptable in terms of size, design, location and method of illumination and will preserve the character and appearance of the host building and the conservation area.

The replacement signage, due to its nature and location, will not harm neighbouring amenity or safety of public highway users.

No objections were made to the proposed plans. The planning history of the site has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy D4 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
