Consent to Place Tables and Chairs on the Public Highway – Refused

Ref: The Bricklayers Arms, 31 Gresse Street W1T 1QS

Following the end of the public consultation period it has been determined not to issue you consent to place tables and chairs on the public highway. You applied for:

7 Tables, 20 Chairs, 5 Barriers and 3 Umbrellas
Monday to Saturday 12:00- 23:00
Sunday 12:00- 22:00

Concerns have been raised in relation to the proposal. Please see a summary of concerns below:

The plan indicates that the tables and chairs zone would be placed to the rear of the site on the carriageway of Stephen Mews. It would not be looked over by the pub, which is against our policy. The barrier nearest the pub appears to block a fire exit, which would not be acceptable. In addition, we normally do not allow tables and chairs on the carriageway. The proposal is therefore unacceptable on various grounds and should be refused.
