Key to the table

Council Tax band - this determines how much Council Tax you pay.

Council Tax band

For Council Tax purposes, all properties have a Council Tax band (A-H in England, A-I in Wales). The band is based on the property's value on 1 April 1991 (for England) or

Improvement indicator - If a property has been improved or extended since it was placed in a Council Tax band, the VOA can't review the banding to take account of the alterations until it's sold. Once a sale takes place the banding will be reviewed. As each Council Tax band covers a range of values, the band isn't always increased following

Mixed use property - a property can have a domestic or mixed use - "yes" identifies a mixed use property.

Court code - a court code shows the Council Tax band has been reviewed by a Valuation Tribunal or the High Court.

Court code

A property will have a court code if the Council Tax band has been changed (determination) or confirmed (confirmation) by a Valuation Tribunal or High Court. The codes
