I live at 179 King's Cross Road and would like to comment on the revised drawings.

We strongly object to the planned building work. The new plans don't address our concerns regarding loss of privacy, light and sky view. The proposed third-floor balcony will lead to a loss of amenity to the four grade II listed buildings 173-179 King's Cross Road, including a loss of privacy and amenity of the buildings and gardens to us residents.

The revision does also not remove any part of the proposed extensions and there is still a balcony planned to overlook our houses and gardens. We will not withdraw our objection until our concerns have been adequately addressed by the applicant.
