We live at 12 Greenaway Gardens and have received a letter of notification of intended works to trees in a conservation area.

We have tried to access the application online, but the service is unavailable.

As owners and occupiers of No.12, we are concerned by the nature of the works being proposed to the trees in the garden, part of which backs onto and overlooks our garden.
