e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

Lime - Street Tree T1 on Plan. Cut back epicormic growth overhanging site to provide 2.5 metres clearance of building line and windows of habitable rooms. Thin epicormic growth within crown by 25-30%. Removed deadwood and minor damaged branches. Reason - To reduce a source of nuisance, increase light levels to habitable rooms and remove a potential hazard to building and highway users.

Holm Oak - Within Site T2 on Plan. Cut back epicormic growth overhanging site to provide 2.5 metres clearance of building line and windows of habitable rooms. This epicomic growth within crown by 25-30% Reason - To reduce a source of nuisance, increase light levels to habitable rooms. Start to develop a permanent frame of branches ensuring tree is managed

and maintained in a safe and sustainable way in the future.
