Application for approval under Schedule 17 of High Speed Rail (London - West Midlands) Act 2017 of lorry routes to and from the Melton Street LU Substation associated with the construction, excavation and above ground construction of the replacement London Underground Traction Substation and Vent Shaft. Main works activities include: capping beam, propping and excavation of the piled box; RC structures; headhouse fit out and envelope; Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing and Heating (MEPH) and associated enabling works. Incorporating lorry routes via: Transport for London Road Network (TLRN), Melton Street, Cardington Street, Albany Street, Osnaurgh Terrace, Osnaurgh Street and Great Portland Street.
