
## **Shorts Gardens**

#### Introduction


This Report is submitted to discharge planning condition 05 associated with the consented proposals at the development site of 60-70 Shorts Gardens & 14-16 Betterton Street located within London Borough of Camden. The planning consent is listed under reference 2019/3501/P.

Condition 05 refer to sample panels of the facing brickwork demonstrating the proposed colour, texture, face-bond and pointing for facing brick to the following elements:

- replacement vent shaft building
- Betterton Street roof extension.

With agreement of the local authority, sample panels of the proposals have been constructed on site and photographic evidence provided within this report to allow discharge of the condition..

#### **Existing Vent Shaft Building**




EXISTING VENT SHAFT BUILDING ON SHORTS GARDENS

- The existing brick vent shaft is not viable for retention and as part of the planning process it was agreed to be demolished, and a new red brick facade would be built in its place.
- The adjacent main factory building is a red brick facade from time of construction. The mortar mix is sandy in tone and is characterised with a slight weatherstruck mortar joint which can be seen below typically 8-10mm in thickness.




BRICK DETAIL OF MAIN SHORTS GARDENS FACADE



LOCATION OF VENT SHAFT ON EXISTING GROUND PLAN




#### **New Build Shorts Gardens Masonry Facade**




EXTRACT OF PROPOSED SHORTS GARDENS FACADE - NEW BRICKWORK IN RED OUTLINE

- The vent shaft is replaced with a new red brick 3 storey facade on the streetline to replace existing.
- A solid brick pier forms the corner return abutting the existing red brick factory faced. A double storey hit & miss brickwork screen occupised the central upper section of the new masonry facade.
  - Metal screens/doors complete the ground level composition

#### **New Build Shorts Gardens Masonry Facade**



- The brick selected is the Mellowed Red Sovereign Stock, a solid red stock brick manufactured by Wienerberger in metric standard size.
- In keeping with the consent brickwork will be laid generally in English Bond (subject to specifics of hit/ miss detailing), with mortar joints to match existing brickwork mortar joint thickness's of the main Shorts Gardens masonry facade.
- Mortar joints will be flush joints to match the adjacent main factory facade, with a mortar mix which is sandy in tone to match existing.




#### **Existing Host Betterton Street Building**




EXISTING BETTERTON STREET MASONRY BUILDING

- Betterton Street building is a seperate block constructed of a typical London yellow stock brick. Existing brick will be cleaned as part of the works.
- The brickwork bares similarities to the Shorts Gardens buildings by it's formation in English Bond. The mortar mix is sandy in tone and is characterised with a slight weatherstruck mortar joint which can be seen below, again similar to Shorts Gardens.









LOCATION OF BETTERTON STREET BUILDING, GROUND PLAN



#### **New Build Betterton Street Masonry Extension**




- A 2 storey masonry extension is proposed, angular in form in brickwork to match the host building.
- A largely glazed facade sets back from street, however 2 flush masonry walls extend up on each gable (east & west). These feature a number of windows concealed behind hit & miss brickwork.
  - The bonding is varied and a textural element is introduced through semi-recessed detailing.




EXTRACT OF PROPOSED EAST FACADE - NEW BRICKWORK IN RED OUTLINE

#### **New Build Betterton Street Masonry Extension**



- The brick selected is the Hampstead Yellow, a modern London stock equivalent, manufactured by Bespoke Brick Company in metric standard size.
  - In keeping with the consent, brickwork will be laid generally in English Bond, with typical 10mm joints.
     In addition there is a stretcher bond perimeter to the composition. Hit & miss is used with glazing behind, in addition the brickwork is laid with alternating semirecessed headers/stretchers.
  - Mortar joints will be flush joints to match the host building below, with a mortar mix which is sandy in tone to match existing.






