Proposal:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) (T1) - Section fell to ground level.
1 x Sycamore x 1 (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) (T2) - Re-pollard by approx. 5m.

The Council has considered your application dated 29 April 2021 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The sycamores are highly visible from the public realm, they are considered to provide visual amenity and to make a positive contribution to the character and appearance of the conservation area.

The application alleges that the trees are causing damage to the adjacent property however no evidence has been provided to substantiate this claim.

It is considered that the proposed works would be detrimental to the character and

appearance of the area. The works have been refused to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and preserve the character and appearance of the conservation area.
