1 x London Plane (T2) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 08 July 2021 and decided to **OBJECT** to the following work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x London Plane (T1) -: Fell to ground level.

## Reasons for objection:

The plane listed as T1 on the application form is a large tree with good form and would appear to have a significant safe useful life expectancy. The plane is visible from the rear of properties and gardens along Buckland Crescent, College Crescent, Adamson Road and Crossfield Road. Rear boundary trees are characteristic of the area and this tree is considered to make a positive contribution to the character and appearance of the conservation area.

The application states that damage to the rear boundary wall and shading as the reasons for removing the tree.

These are not considered to be sufficient reasons to justify the removal of a tree that is considered worthy of being brought under the protection of a tree preservation order. The wall is in need of rebuilding and could be rebuilt in such a way as to take account of the presence of the tree or be replaced with a fence. Shading is not considered a reason to remove a tree.

A tree preservation order has been served to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and preserve the character and appearance of the conservation area.

## A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.

However, the Council would not have any objection to the carrying out of the following works:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x London Plane (T2) - Fell to ground level.
