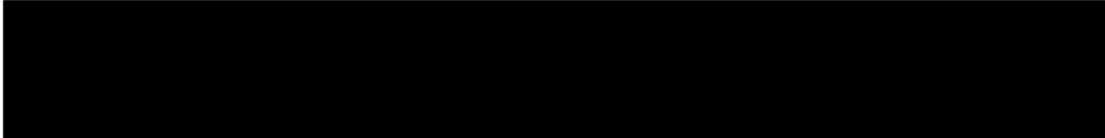

It has been brought to our attention that the council are in favour of an application to put a 3rd floor in this property at 10 Belsize Mews. We are concerned that the owner of this property seems intent to significantly modify the property after failed building applications.
