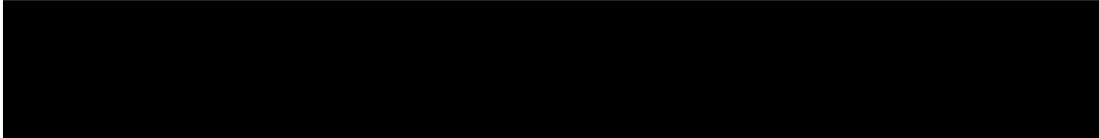

To Nathaniel Young, Camden Planning:

I am writing regarding the planning application at 106 King Henry's Road - 2021/3370/P. I am a neighbour and live across the street, at 123 King Henry's Road.

I am aware the period for commenting has come to an end, but this only came to my attention a few days ago.

The application seeks to extend the property one more storey. I am against this for several reasons:

1. Visually, it would massively impact the uniformity of the street.
2. It would block light on the surrounding buildings.
3. It would set the precedent for all of the houses on the Chalcots Park Estate to further extend upwards, which will have a massive impact on the Elsworthy Conservation Area, which even though the estate is not a part of, the limit is just across the street.
4. I have seen there are similar applications where permission has been granted, but these properties don't seem to have a big impact on the conservation area since they are further away from it.
5. The application seeks to extend a further storey after the applicants have already added a basement to the property.

I hope my comments are considered when this application is reviewed.
