I am sorry that I missed the deadline for commenting on this application, which does not seem to have been well publicised in the neighbourhood.

The application seeks permission to erect an additional storey above an existing property. No other adjacent property yet has an additional storey, so this application would, if approved, set a far-reaching precedent.

If the Council approves applications for an additional storey for any property in this row of houses, I hope that it will insist on reasonable stylistic unity to preserve the generally uniform appearance of these properties.

I note that a row of similar properties in Elliott Square (overlooking King Henry's Road) received permission to erect an additional storey, and this has been achieved in a way that preserves stylistic unity along the row of houses: the design of the new storey is uniform across the entire development.
