## Reason(s) for Refusal

- The siting and scale of the proposed kiosk, on the footway at this location, would impair the safety of users of the highway, particularly pedestrians. The proposal would therefore be contrary to the Council's policies for promoting walking and highway safety. It would be contrary to policy T1 and TC4 of the LB Camden Local Plan, the London Plan 2021 and the NPPF 2021.
- Due to its prominent siting, design and appearance, the proposed kiosk would harm the character and appearance of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area. It is therefore contrary to policy D2 (Heritage) of the LB Camden Local Plan 2017, the London Plan 2021 and the NPPF 2021.
