Proposal: Ground floor internal alterations and rear extension.

Summary: The CAAC has no objection to this proposal which maintains the

characteristics of the conservation area.

Comments:

1. There are concerns about the technical adequacy of the drawings.

- 1.1. The drawings lack the required information about materials. The design and access statement and the application form note brickwork to match existing, but there is no mention of material for the sliding doors.
- 1.2. Section A-A shows the current ceiling height running uninterrupted into the extension, even though a sizeable beam will be required to support the bay above.

Date: 19 October 2021

- As to the choice of materials, to achieve the very slim frames on the sliding doors, they must be metal. In the circumstances this is appropriate, as timber framing would have an undesirably heavy effect.
- Apart from these technical considerations, which should have been resolved prior to registration, the CAAC has no objection to this proposal
