Dear Mr Greenhalgh,

I am writing in support of the planning application 2021/3105/P, for the Highgate and Muswell Hill Eruv. I grew up in Highgate and frequently visit my family who still live there. The Eruv will enable me and my husband, [REDACTED], to attend services in the local synagogue, to visit friends and to participate in community life. Currently we are unable to do so to a full extent since on the Jewish Sabbath (Friday night and Saturday, when most services and socialisation occurs) we cannot carry or push prams under Jewish law. The construction of the Eruv will allow us to carry in its limits and eliminates the unnessecary discrimination against families with young children. I personally know many other families who live in the area who would also benefit from an Eruv.

Furthermore, my father has taken me round the neighbourhood, showing me the places where proposed poles are to be placed and I can vouch for the care and concern with which the spots were chosen to minimise visual impact.
