I do not object to the re-pollarding and tying in of the lateral growth of the Limes (T1-4) or the work on the Lime (T5). I understand why the gardener wants to fell the Chinese Privet as its crown and those of the Lime (T4) compete with each other. However, it is an unusual tree. (The two Silver Birches are to be retained).

I did/do no object to the application to work on the Bay tree in the front garden. However, today, on my second visit, most of the bay tree was inside a lorry. There was not much evidence of 'the shaping and re-balancing' applied for. On neither occasion could I see any evidence of a Willow sapling. I was not allowed into the back garden by the builders, so am unable to comment on the Elder (T3) felling or the mixed shrub (G2) group felling and treating both with systemic herbicide.
