As a resident in the same street I strongly object to this proposal. We are in a conservation area and gradually we are seeing more and more high rise buildings such as the one next to Belsize tube station and the extra level built over the shops adjacent to Howitt Road, already blocking light for us now. Howitt Close is already is seen from all angles if you look Howitt Road. It already does not fit with the other buildings. Adding another floor will block out afternoon light and sun for the entire street? There is no mention of any report on this being done, but standing on the street at 4.30pm today I could see this would be the consequence.

What about the precedent it sets? Would this be the first of many more buildings? There are many similar flat roofed apartment buildings, particularly in Belsize grove, which would also affect the residents of Howitt Road on the south side who back onto them.

Surely , if this application is approved, the council will not be able to legally object the barrage of applications that will follow from every property owner on Howitt Road and the surrounding area to add another floor to their property?
