In particular we are opposed to the plan of adding a balcony to the rear and side of the building as well as to the enlarging of a window to make it into a balcony door. This infringes the privacy of some of the lower flats of No 10 as well as increases the light pollution for the upper flats of No. 10.

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2021/3813/P	Folliot	20/10/2021 14:43:31	OBJ	<p>We occupy Flat 1 on the ground floor and first floor of adjoining property at number 10 and we submit our objection to this application.</p> <p>Precisely - we are very concerned about the new balcony and staircase on the side of the house (see South East Elevation) which will be very visible over the shared garden wall both from the windows of our bedrooms on the side of the house, from our garden and more importantly from our living room (in our current extension). Pictures sent to planning@camden.gov.uk.</p> <p>It should be noted that the space between the partition wall and the house at number 8 is very narrow and the balcony will be towering over our pathway and will have views inside our flat.</p> <p>The proposed scheme clearly raises an important and insurmountable issue for our privacy.</p> <p>The scheme proposes to address this with opaque privacy glazing but when people are on the balcony or in the staircase, they will have unobstructed views on our property.</p> <p>It should also be noted that from an architectural perspective, the current side elevation of the house is much more harmonious, balanced and a much nicer sight for all than with the addition of a balcony and a flight of stairs, destroying some of the historical features of the building.</p> <p>Best regards</p>
