Consent to Place Tables and Chairs on the Public Highway - Refused

Following the end of the public consultation period it has been determined not to issue you consent to place tables and chairs on the public highway. You applied for:

1 Table, 4 Chairs, 1 Umbrella and 1 Heater Monday-Wednesday 08:00-22:00 Thursday-Saturday 08:00-22:30 Sunday 08:00-22:00 New Application

Concerns have been raised in relation to the proposal. Please see a summary of concerns below:

This is a narrow pavement which also comprises a loading bay directly in front of it and a street lamp. The proposed furniture will cause significant disruption to an already tight space.

Further crowding in this area will create a hazard for disabled people, children and young families.

The proposed furniture will cause an unacceptable disruption to those with mobility needs. It will discourage pedestrians from using the footway.

The measurements depicted on plan do not seem accurate, need to assess the footpath access and whether there is sufficient room.
