Evaluation and sustainability.

The application is to move recent partitioning for new cold store and associated fan units.

We plan to replace 3 ancient freezer units and 3 fridge units with a walk in free standing cold room. This is critical to the running of the public house. We looked into alternatives, the only being replacing independent fridges and freezers. These however, are much less efficient than the option of a single walk in cold room. Both in energy, heat created and noise.

There are only 2 condenser units involved and these are mounted hidden on the roof. All internal pipe work runs through disused store rooms and the staircase to the roof. There is no works to the building fabric and none of the pipe runs are visible.

Design Proposal
