2) Honey locust - reduce to former pruning points

4) Oak at no.50 - reduce to former pruning points

6) Japanese maple - Lift lower edge of the crown to 2 - 2.5m by removing lower branches

8) Cherry - dying, fell
9) Sycamore - Shorten the lower branch over the garden of no.50 by 3 - 4m. Remove the smaller second and third branches above that. (Cut ivy stems round the base of the trunk.)

10) Sycamore in garden to the rear - Increase clearance by removing lower secondary branches from the first main branch over the garden. This is all over no.48.

13) Cherry in garden ofno.46 - Cut back overhanging growth up to 5m. (Would need owner's agreement to cut back to the trunk in line with good practice.)
